On the page previous the name of John G. Adams was mentioned, since I have received something on this man I feel that this is a place to insert it here. This was sent to me by Mary Adams 1206 Madison, Springfield, Mo. 65806.

Rev. John G. Adams, a native of Clark County, Ky., was born on 8/8/1827. His father, John Adams, a native of Culpeper County Va., was born in 1775, emigrated to Ky., where he first settled in Clark County, removed to Madison, then to Estill Co., and finally settled permanently in Clark County, he was a farmer by occupation and was a member of the Calvinistic Baptist Church 75 years. He married Elizabeth Parrish, a native of Madison County, Ky., daughter of William Parrish, a native of Virginia. She bore him seven sons and two daughters, the subject of this sketch being the eighth child. Mrs. Adams died in 1860, having been a consistent member of the Calvinistic Baptist Church for 45 years. John Adams died at the age of 98 years 9 months and 7 days. Elkany Adams, grandfather of John G., a native of Virginia, settled in Clark County, Ky., where he died shortly after his arrival. He was one of those who fought for America's Independence. The maternal grandfather of our subject was an early settler of Madison Co., Ky. John G. Adams was reared on a farm, the pursuits of which he followed until 19 years of age, when he worked for a time at the saw-mill business; then he apprenticed himself to learn the blacksmith trade with Robert W. Langley of Dry Fork. (Said Langley after removed to Texas.) He successfully engraved in his trade for 18 years, when he began farming and preaching. He engaged in ministerial work in 1863, his pastoral labor being confined chiefly to Clark, Powell, Estill and Madison Counties. He settled on his present location about 1857, where he owns 378 acres of land in two tracts, all well improved, which he successfully manages. June 21, 1847, he married Miss Millie Rucker of Clark County, daughter of Reuben and Margaret (Hardin) Rucker, natives respectively, of Va., and Clark County, Ky. Twelve children have been born to their union; viz: Sarah H., Mary J., Telitha F., Nancy B., Emma T., Reuben A., Sallie, Esther, Millie J., and Fielding. Lucy J. deceased. Politically Mr. Adams is a Democrat. He has been a member of the Christian Church since 1862. He has attained the third degree in the Masonic fraternity. Mrs. Adams has been a member of the Christian Church for 40 years.

Elkany Adams was probably Eleannah. The Cahany in your Bible is probably a derivation of the name Eleannah. We had a Micajah John Adams in our line who was called Cajer John even on the tax records.

Mary Adams sent me one other note-There was two Spencer Adams in Kentucky at the same time and this refers to the other one.

Payton Foster Adams continued to serve in the Methodist Conference and served at Standeys, Perryville, Broodsville, Mt. Olivet and finally Jackson again before he was sent to Pineville where he died, in 1843. While he did this work which was his calling he served on several committees and was serving in the committee that decided to take over the Samaritan Hospital in Lexington, Ky. I felt that he was going a good work on this type of his work and talked many time of what they had accomplished. He was the youngest child of Payton Foster Adams Sr. and it is regrettable that his father did not live long enough to have seen who and what he had accomplished. He was my father and ~~my~~ son had ever had a better father that I was able to enjoy. He at all times talked with me that he wanted me to attend College, even though he knew that he would not be able to supply the money. It was because of his encouragement that I was made it though the University of Kentucky. It took me five years and one summer school but I made it in 1927, with a Bs in Me. Father had a heavy load to carry with a daughter to educate and a wife who was sick and I did not get care at all what I did in order to get my education, in fact I have been able to tell others that I want to College on a Work Scholarship. (S) amada wad .C

I have come to the end of my Adams History and while I was working on this I was writing to others in an effort to learn more about our Family, especially who was the father of my Great Great Grandfather, Spencer Adams, but so far in ~~about~~ 6/1/1976 I don't know any more that I started with when I had about two years ago. I have learned about many folks that I did not know existed. Cousins and others who have been nice to me and I am very ~~satisfied~~ thankful. I hope to continue this work until I will some day find the answer that I am looking to find, then maybe I can do something to this so it will be a complete work.

As I look back over the men that helped Clark County Kentucky get started and fight to get this part of the country come the Commonwealth of Kentucky I have learned that Men by the name of Adams had much to do in this work. I have tried to give you their names in this paper and one of them was a man by Elkannah Adams that sold their land in Pittsylvania County Va., and moved to Kentucky. What was the relation of Spencer Adams and Harris Adams and Elkannah Adams is still a mystery but I am sure that they were related and that these three men as far as I am been able to tell are the beginning of the Adams Families over Kentucky and much of the other western States. In my search for the Father of the father of Spencer Adams I have learned much about this Elkannah Adams and his descendents, so because I am trying to write a paper on the Adams Family in Clark County Kentucky I will give you what I have learned about Elkannah Adams and his wife Mary in the following pages. ## A HISTORY OF THE ADAMS FAMILY IN CLARK COUNTY KENTUCKY.

This is the year of 1976 and all over our Nation our people every where are celebrating the Bi-Centennial, then as we look back over the times that has happened to bring us to this state in our existance, ~~we look~~ as the cause and why people coming to this country and settling, we find that many fine families joined together to make these United States of America. Since by the accident of birth I am from the name of one of the oldest and one of the one prominent ~~family~~ families that helped to put our Nation together. The Adams name was one of the first to show on these shores and it was by the help of these men that people put our Nation together.

Back in the early time of our Country, there were two men by the name of Adams that came to America to settle, both had much to do in the early times, to found our Future.

One of these men, was Thomas Adams who landed in Virginia in 1648 with a Patent for 2000 acres of land in the territory now occupied as Spottsylvania and Sulpepper Countyes. It is unfortunate that very few facts of this man other than he started a trend in population in the State of Virginia with men who carried the name of Thomas Adams. It has been said that if all the men in Va., could be brought together in one place that the result would be a large town of only Thomas Adams in it. I feel that the reason that why not much is known of this man is that he and his descendents, did not get into the eyes of the people as did the one that came to America a few year before and settle at Braintree Mass.

Henry Adams came to America in the settling of this country and because his descendents became promenant, much more, is known about him and his descendents

Henry Adams lived and came to America from from Barton David, England. He was born in 1583 and died in 1646 at Mass. in Braintree. He was married to Edith Squire (1487-1673). This couple has nine children but unfortunately six of his sons are not named on a paper I was able to get from the Braintree Library. One daughter was not named but there was one son, John Adams of Menotomy in Cambridge (1622-1706) who married Ann---, There was another son named as ~~in~~ Joseph Adams of Braintree ( 1626-1694), who married Abigail Baxter (1624-1692). It is these two sons that Key Pedigree of some descendents of Henry Adams was traced. Many fine men down from the first, John Adams the man that we heard ~~most~~ most of about, came down from the second named son, Joseph Adams of Braintree (1626-1694) and his wife Abigail Baxter (1634-1692). It was the descendents of this couple that we have John Adams and John Quincy Adams who were Presidents of our Nation. These men were educated at Harvard and John Adams sturded for the Ministry and did not take up ~~his~~ until after he returned home from Harvard. There was a cousin of John Adams that helped much in the early times in and around Boston in setting our Revolution and the Declaration of Independence, with his writing and publishing in his newspaper in Boston. This was Samuel Adams. There seem to have been two of these men. Samuel Adams of Boston (1689-1748) who married Mary Pifield (no date given on her.) The other was Gov. Samuel Adams of Boston (1722-1803) who married for his 1st wife Elizabeth Checkley and from this couple there was five children but there was not names ~~diven~~ diver. His 2nd wife was Elizabeth Wells (only date given was 1764- what this repersentex is not clear.) There did not seem to be any children ~~ex~~ from this marriage, but we do know that one of these Samuel Adams had a newspaper in Boston an that John Adams wrote many times for his cousin's paper. There are many good stories of Samuel Adams but there are to many and large to include them in this paper.

It is unfortunate that our records are not enough, so that we have a clear story of all the people that complete the Adams families but it seems that many have
