Dear Kathryn Owen,

Today I met with a woman on the Palmer family. There is an error in the material that I sent you.

Rolly Palmer and Philadelphia Morton's daughter, Agnes, was not married to James Hugh McBride. The Agnes who married him was the daughter of Martillus and Nancy Moody Palmer. Both Agnes and James are buried here in Boone County. Also, do you want a copy of the family group sheet for Martillus Palmer, son of Rolly (Rawlugh) Palmer?

Do you have a copy of Richard Morton's will? I found some marriages on the Mortons for you. They were in a book, Marriages of Prince Edward County Va 1754-1810 Compiled & Edited by Catherine L. Knorr. They are: pg. 56. Letty McCargo, dau. of John McCargo, + Jonathan Morton 25 November 1784, pg. 77. Susanna Morton, dau. of Richard Morton, + William Ginsley 17 November 1786, pg. 49. Lucy Morton + Redford McCargo 26 January 1786. Archibald Morton + Elizabeth Woodall, dau. of Wm. Woodall 5 January 1792, pg. 62 Sarah Morton dau. of Samuel Morton + William Perkins 10 September 1794.

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Do you have anything on John Morton
son of Richard and Judith Quin Morton?
Could you tell me all you know about
both Richard Morton and his wife
Judith Quin.

From what records I have looked
at, the Morton family only lived
in Prince Edward County for 20
years. I'm going to try to trace them
backwards. They may have lived
in Charlotte Co Va before moving to
Prince Edward Co Va.

I still haven't found Joseph Palmer's
marriage. I'm not giving up. I
did find that his father Rawleigh
Palmer born (1733) died about 1787
in Richmond Co Va. That is when
his estate was settled. I'm going
to try to get copies of the wills of Robert
and Joseph Palmer. I'll let you know
how that turns out.

My husband is talking about taking
a vacation at Kentucky Lake. I
I'm going to try to get them to
make a side trip to Winchester
so we can meet. Hope to see you
this summer.

Dear Kathryn,

Thank you so much for the information on the Crosthwaites. I have had a lot of trouble tracing them. I knew my Thomas Stone was married to Cynthia Crosthwaite from her father, Thomas Crosthwaites, will. If I want you the money could you get me a copy of their marriage? Thomas Stone and Cynthia Crosthwaite had a daughter Susan Perry Stone who married Philip Wade Palmer son of Raleigh (Relley) Palmer and Philadelphia Morton.

I also would like to get a copy of Relley and Philadelphia's marriage. I have tried writing to the courthouse to get them but didn't succeed.

I don't think that the other two marriages for Thomas Stone, are for my Thomas. He would have only been 16 or 17 in 1816 & 1817. I think he was born in 1799. His father would have to have given consent for the marriages.

How come you have so much information on the Crosthwaites? I feel fairly certain that my Thomas Crosthwaite (wife Rachel) was a son of Isaac Crosthwait. Thomas died in 1830 and John Crosthwait administrated the will. His wife Rachel died in 1836. I find

it very interesting that the sisters Sarah and Martha Croothwaite both unmarried men named Greening. I have a friend who is married to a man named Greening, probably a relative.

Thank you for the copy of John Harper and Sally Kelins marriage bond. It's rare in my husband's family to find people who could write. Samuel Morton ~~we~~ wrote beautifully.

I couldn't remember what I went you from the parish book in Richmond Co, Va. so I recopied it. I hope you can make sense out of it. I'm glad you think Rawleigh and Eleanor were our Joseph's parents. I felt they were but I like to have a second opinion. It appears that Rawleigh either had only one child or moved shortly after Joseph's birth.

I hope to go to Richmond Va. this summer. I'm going to hunt for Joseph and Elizabeth Langstone marriage. Do you know any thing about her?

I read in a book at our library that a Joseph Palmer was established to death in 1833 in Winchester Ken by Joel V. Collins. Is this our Joseph or his son? Also, in the marriage list I read. Joel Collins was married to an Elizabeth Palmer.

I wonder if he was related to us also.

As soon as I get my information on the Palmers typed, I will send you a copy. How recent do you want? I wrote everything in blue ink so I can't copy it. I didn't realize that blue ink won't copy.

I think I'll try to trace other children of Raubigh Palmer as well as his sister Elizabeth Angel. The Angels here in Boone Co own the livestock exchanges.

Thank you so much for the help you have given me. Now maybe I can trace my Thomas Stone to his father. I know that he was related to Gov. Stone, one of the first governors in Missouri. I think he had two brothers James and Marshall. They lived in Platte Co Mo which is where my Thomas Stone died.

I just got back from Washington DC. I went to the archives to do research. I decided it's easier to write for military & pension records. I didn't get to check on our family at the Library of Congress but I hope to. I'm hoping to go back to Washington in July and go on to Richmond. My family lives near Washington but they are moving soon. I want to get to Richmond this year as it may be a long time before I get another chance. Of course it all depends

on the gas shortage. Rogas, no
vacation.

Dear Kathryn,

I have found a book that might have our Joseph's marriage in it. Actually I only know where a copy of it is. I'm hoping I can find someone to read it for me as it is in Salt Lake City at the Church Library. It is by the same man who compiled the information on North Farmham Parish. It is a listing of all of the marriages in Richmond Co Va from 1663 to 1854. It is several hundred pages long & indexed. I tried to get a copy of the book on microfilm but it won't microfilm as yet. I have searched King George Co marriages in Va and the woman's unmarried there.

I'm enclosing copies of my family pedigree charts. I started with my husband's grandmother. Her parents were both Palmers (1st Cousins) I have also included all the information I have on the Palmers & the Mortons. Keep these from me, so you will know what you have sent me. I copied some of it from other people here in Columbia that you wrote to.

I have never seen war records for any of these people. I have been lax in looking for them, laziness on my part. I hate to fill out forms.

If you really want to write a book on this family, what will go into it I can try to trace the Boone Co families.

Would you want me to trace all the lines I can probably trace Ralley (Rawleigh) children that lived here. I believe his daughter Elizabeth White lived in Clark Co. I may be able to trace some of the Angelo. I know there are a lot of Angelo in Northern Boone Co.

Is any of this family french. I ask because of Demarcus Palmer. That appears to be french.

Does your side of the family carry the white streak and patches? We don't have the white streak but my eldest has some patches on his legs as does my husband.

Do you know which of Joseph's children came to Boone Co? I know Ralley & Elizabeth Angel were here in 1840 & 1850. I also have a James Palmer, born 23 Jan 1787 wife Elizabeth, that I believe was one of Joseph's sons.

You mentioned having copies of some Palmer marriage bonds. I wonder if you have a marriage for Martillus Palmer (I believe he was my Ralley's second son). His wife's name was Nancy.

Thank you so much for the information you have given me on the Stones and Crothwaits. That is one of my more

difficult times.

I really enjoy doing this research. A few months ago I found that my two bands was triple related to a woman the works with. (4th Cousin on two lines and third cousins on another) Now they kid each other about being cousins.

Hope to hear from you soon.

Dear Mrs. Owen,

For more than a decade I've sought the immigrant ancestor of our John Angell of Pendleton County, Ky. and his connection with Falmouth, Stafford Co., Va. I understand that some missing Stafford county records have been recently (1985) ~~been~~ recovered from Britain and indexed by Dr. Louis Manarin, Va. State Archivist but I've had no luck there so far. Early records show Angells in contiguous counties of Northampton, Northumberland, Lancaster Va. counties in mid 1600s. And often Palmers, Barnes and related name connected with them. *Stafford Co*

Several years ago someone sent me a somewhat blurred xerox copy of an article by you entitled WHO WAS WHO IN EARLY CLARK CO. KY. Without exception the names Woodson, Morton, Michaux, Rochet, Quinn McCargo, with Fontaine, Goode- appear in my direct maternal Angell line and are verified by the various heritagr societies to which I belong. And you probably have also pursued further to Magna Charter's de Quincy and Joan Plantagnet line.

The declining health of my husband, loss of my sister (christened Lucy Angell (Small)) and husband and only brother (with sudden *in same year* loss of much of my eyesight) has brought much of my research to a grinding halt ! Proving our immigrant ancestor would be a cheerful conclusion. I have a number of encouraging references to records as early as 1650 , difficult to xerox because copied on colored paper but might be able to furnish some kind of repro-

duction. My Angell line went to Boone Co., Mo. circa 1820 from Pendleton Kentucky and there are descendants there where I still own inherited property and keep in touch.

I hope that you will forgive my typing inaccuracies and that you will be able to produce the long sought link between John Angell and his immigrant predecessor. To re-imburse you for any fees would be a privilege.
