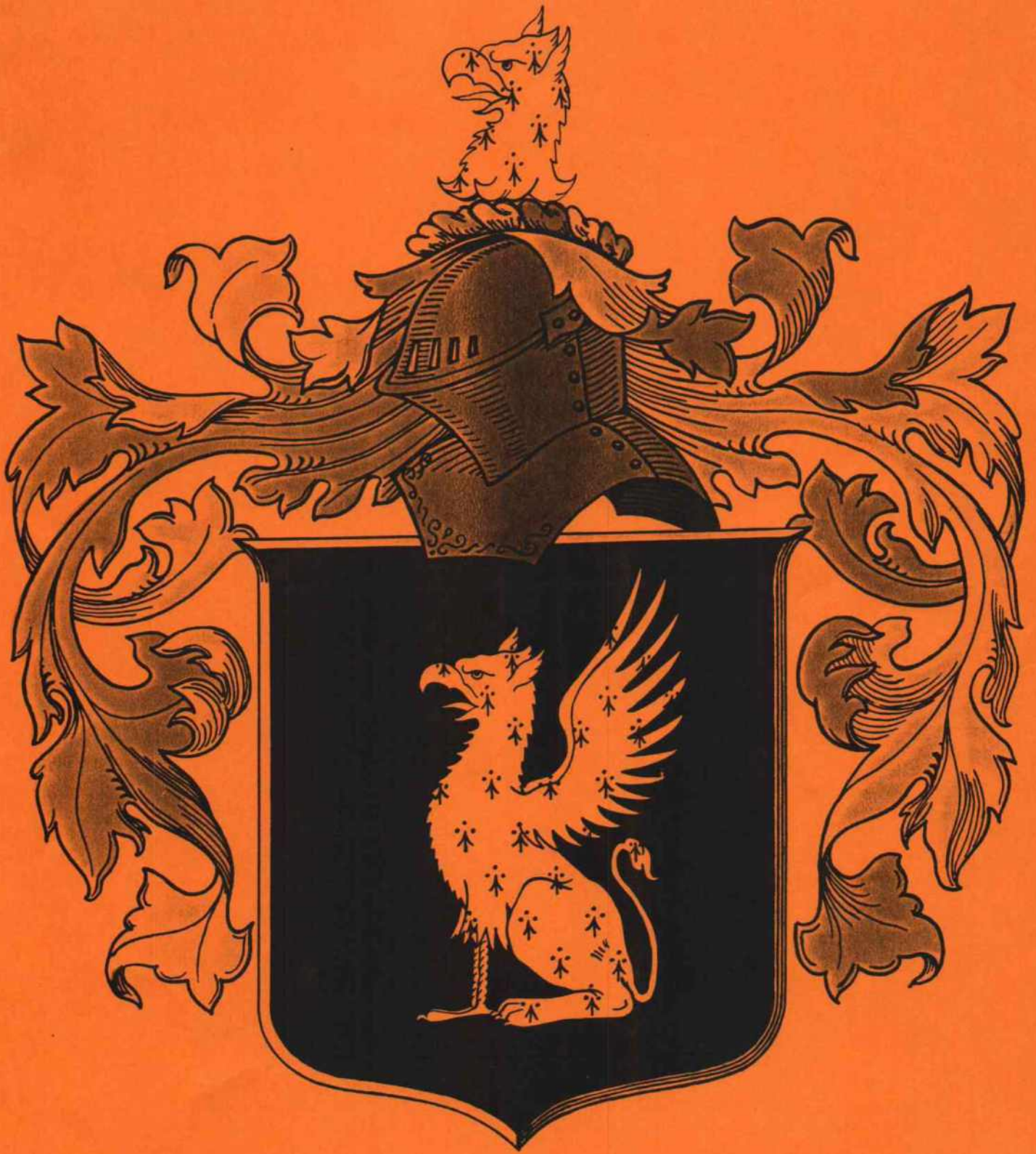

## BALLARDS IN CLARK COUNTY, KY.....1796-\_\_?

Welcome to this information which traces the Clark County Ballard decedents of John William Ballard I (1785-1858). The information from John William Ballard to present, we believe to be correct.

Based on information documented by former Clark County native Nelson Leon Ballard who at this writing retired in Sun City, Arizona and found in his contribution at Clark County Public Library, Winchester, KY, Phillip Ballard is father of John William Ballard I. Relying upon this information, we have included Phillip as part of our ancestry and any information concerning him and his family is included in this document. Therefore, the basis of 1796 in our title accepts the date that Phillip and his wife came from Spotsylvania, Virginia to Clark County, Ky.

Also for your consideration is information presented by Christian Orlov of New York City, NY, (a Ballard descendent who has done much research attempting to locate all members of his family tree):

Mr. Orlov believes that the Phillip Ballard, who came to Clark Co. in 1796, father was also a Phillip Ballard. He issues this excerpt from A BALLARD FAMILY GENEALOGY, by Katherine Cox Gottschalk and J. McFarland Williams, Jr., 1957, N.S.D.A.R. Library Washington, D. C....."Phillip Ballard was the son of a William Ballard. William was of King and Queen Co. and Essex Co. married Phildephia, possibly daughter of Phillip Ludwell. William's father was Thomas of York. Henry Ballard the immigrant son of Thomas Ballard, possibly the above mentioned Thomas born in London was the father of Thomas Ballard, born 1630, died 1689 married Ann Thomas. His son William married Philadelphia. His son Phillip married Ann Johnson." (This copied as typed by Mr. Orlov)

Thanks to all who contributed information for this document. Most are from family records and/or information from family members (All living members in 1994 were given the opportunity to write a resume' about oneself to include in this document. As you go through the information, you will notice that some individuals chose to furnish info while others did not choose to do so or decided to be very brief). Footnotes are made when information came from other sources. Reluctant to mention names of those who helped fearing of hurting someone's feelings if someone overlooked, I do think it only right to mention Katherine Owen for her time and information as well as the inspiration from Nellie Fox's book FOX COUSINS BY THE DOZENS.

Hoping you cherish your American heritage as much as I do, I challenge you to keep this document up to date throughout your lifetime so our decedents will have knowledge of their fore fathers. After completion of this document, I hope the Clark County Public Library will keep a copy on file for anyone who chooses to use the information. I also intend to contact and present a copy to the Mormon Library and KY Genealogy Library if they are interested.

Phillip was revolutionary soldier. His brothers/sisters included William, Ankey, Thomas, Ann, Mooreman, Curtis, Larkin, Lucy, Johnson, Milley, Delphia, Elijah in Virginia. Phillip sold 45 acres in Albemarle Co., VA on Sept. 8, 1795. The next year, 1796, he and part of his family moved to Clark Co., KY. His family lived on 43A which was part of farm where Nelson Leon Ballard was born. Walter Ballard sold the farm in 1958 which was then 169 acres.

In 1841, James W. operated a grocery store on North Main Street in Winchester, KY. He was a partner with his father-in-law, James Cole. In 1859 he purchased a 200 acre tract of land adjoining Winchester which is actually located beginning Boone Ave and Maple St South. It was known as Ballard's Woods. In the 20th century, some of the nicer homes in Winchester have been built on this land. James W. and wife lived in 2nd house on left from corner Boone/Maple before the land was sold by heirs upon his death (The house actually was built facing Boone Ave. The original house had additions to it including part which now faces Maple). James W. also purchased acreage of 179, 236, 368, 69 along 4 Mile Creek in 1850-60's. (along what also known as Muddy Creek Road) Included in this document are copies of some deeds, particularly when James W. holdings were divided among his heirs.

Kate was an invalid during the last 23 years of her life. She was first a member of United Baptist Church and in 1868 joined the Christian Church and exemplified a most Christian lady.

George J. was farmer living on the Muddy Creek Pike w/about 350 acres which was a part of vast land originally owned by his father, James W. As a young adult, George logged on the KY River at Jackson Ferry. George raised show stock and traveled to the State Fairs to show them. It appears that George J. began what it is known as the Ballard home place on Muddy Creek. On the home place, there sits a large barn which had facilities for a dairy. It is not known whether George ran a dairy. There is a photo of a dairy wagon with Ballard Dairy written on it and grandson T. J. remembers him selling cream etc. from it when he lived in town. The family lived in a residence on corner of northeastern corner of Washington and Highland Streets (Which still stands at this writing). Grandchildren, Eva, George Mason, and Eugene lived with George J. during school year so they could attend city schools. There are pictures of George and wife on beaches in Florida. In their later years resided on Buckner Street in Winchester.

Eva, George's wife, was very artistic doing hand work and paintings. Eva had cancer. Local doctors gave her morphine to which she became addicted and never overcame, even though she left state for help.

Jesse was raised on Muddy Creek pike and farmed the @ 359 acres which came into family as a result of grandfathers (James W.) purchases. Jesse mainly raised sheep having as many as 300 head at one time. A few cattle raising calves were also on the farm. Jesse worked at the Winchester Stockyards located by railroad tracks on East Broadway for many years. Other land in the family was farm on Dry Fork Road which eventually Eugene bought; the Lew Rainey farm (wife Mary's father) located directly across road from Ballard farm; Watt's place located 3 acres directly across road from Muddy Creek Country Store and 13 acres including Country Store running up Dry Fork Road behind store (This originally purchased by T.J. Ballard). Jesse was led to the Lord by a close friend at @ age 50 and joined the Corinth Baptist Church.

Mary, Jesse's wife, lived directly across road from Ballard farm. She was one of twelve children of Lewis R. Rainey. (Lewis R. Rainey graveyard located on property formerly owned by him off Dry Fork Road at highest point of closest acreage in rear of Eugene Ballard farm.) Mary became known by everyone in the community and beyond because of caring nature. She had many flowers in her huge yard; raised many chickens, a huge garden, grapes which she made into wine (as well as blackberries); made lye soap, separated cream from milk, churned butter, made lard from each fall's hog killing time and so many other things which were a part of life known in those days. When family members would drop in, she would immediately fire up her stove and put meal in the skillet for cornbread, which was also served at all meals. Family members always looked forward for Thanksgiving and Christmas, not only to get together, but because of the wide spread and variety of foods which Mary prepared by herself and placed on the huge dining room table. Mary not only had her own children but she also took care of mentally retarded brother, Ernest known as "Hag", and another gentleman who came to live in the cabin, John Parker. The grandchildren knew they always had one person to whom they could turn no matter what reason, Mary known as "MOM" to grandchildren.

Eva lived during the school year with her grandparents, George J. and Eva on corner of Washington St. and Highland St., and attended Washington Street and Hickman Street Elementary Schools. She graduated from Winchester High School. Eva and husband Chester farmed on northern half of lot 6 as divided from estate of Great Grandfather James W. Ballard and willed to Martha E. Ballard and husband Jack Wills. They were able to purchase the 85+ acres with help of a loan from parents Jesse and Mary. Eva raised a large garden and grapes. Eva was a very devoted member and worker in the First Baptist Church.

Chester attended The Wills and Mooresville schools. He grew up on the Green farm located on corner of Logan Lick and Muddy Creek Roads across road from farm he and Eva resided. Chester farmed with Eva and also harvested honey from his hive of honey bees. Chester was on Clark County School Board for a time. Chester was a deacon and most dedicated member of First Baptist Church. (Address: 3925 Muddy Creek Road)

Treffert walked and attended Hunt Elem. He was able to ride with teacher part of the time because he agreed to go early so he start and build fire in pot bellied stove used for heating. He also attended Mooresville Elem. one year and graduated from Clark Co H.S. Name interesting as spelled same backwards as forward. Name chosen as a result of parents overhearing the name mentioned by out of state tourists at Natural Bridge State Park. T. J. membership at First Baptist Church. One of T.J.'s fondest memories was having Grand Champion Hereford at Fair @ 1927 besting some well known hereford raisers in those days. Treffert loved hunting or trapping small game such as fox, mink, rabbit, squirrel. Fishing was a life long avocation mostly in KY River, Herrington Lake, and creeks in the area. T.J. managed and farmed the family farm which his father, Jesse J. and grandfather George J. inherited from James W. estate believed to be lots 4 & 5. Sheep (western ewes bred by southdowns) raising including shearing the wool was a fact of life as well as eventually growing tobacco, corn, hay, and raising several head of cattle. Treffert also at times hauled coal (used mainly for home heating) from the mountains for himself as well as selling to others. He also drove cousin Taylor Rainey's truck in transporting tobacco and corn, some out of state. In @ 1947, T.J. lived and worked with railroad in Lexington for a short time. T.J. for a while owned lower half of Jack

Wills farm (originally James W. Ballard estate lot 6). T.J. and wife bought 16 acres Watt's place located on northwest corner of Ballard farm and across road where Muddy Creek Country Store sat. They lived in Watt's house from about 1948 to late 1960's when after T.J.'s several heart problems moved to 119 Waveland Ave. in Winchester. T.J. retired from Ky Transportation Dept. after @ 13 years of service in 1980's. T.J. had open heart surgery in 1983 which left him clinically disabled. Treffert, well known for hard working (daylight to dark) most trustworthy and dependability. He helped out many of a person who stopped at home in any hours of day and night with transportation problems using his tractor or other equipment to rescue a person in time of need. At age 80, collecting aluminum cans became a hobby as well as his continued love for fishing and caring for small dog. (Wanted to work but unable)

Leona attended Clark Co. H.S. She was daughter of tenant farmer and grew up on Burgher farm (later owned by Fox and eventually Jack Ross) just outside of Winchester on Muddy Creek Pike. Leona married at age 15 and gave birth to only child, J.W., at age 16. She worked at Richmond's Army Depot in younger years and later years at Lexington Army Depot (Avon). The couples, T.J., Leona and Delores, M.B. had been very close friends for most of their lives visiting each others' home mostly on weekends to play friendly games of cards for entertainment. Delores attended Hickman St. Elem. and St. Agatha Academy. She was one of Leona's buddies on swimming/beach bathing outings. She retired from GTE/Sylvania.

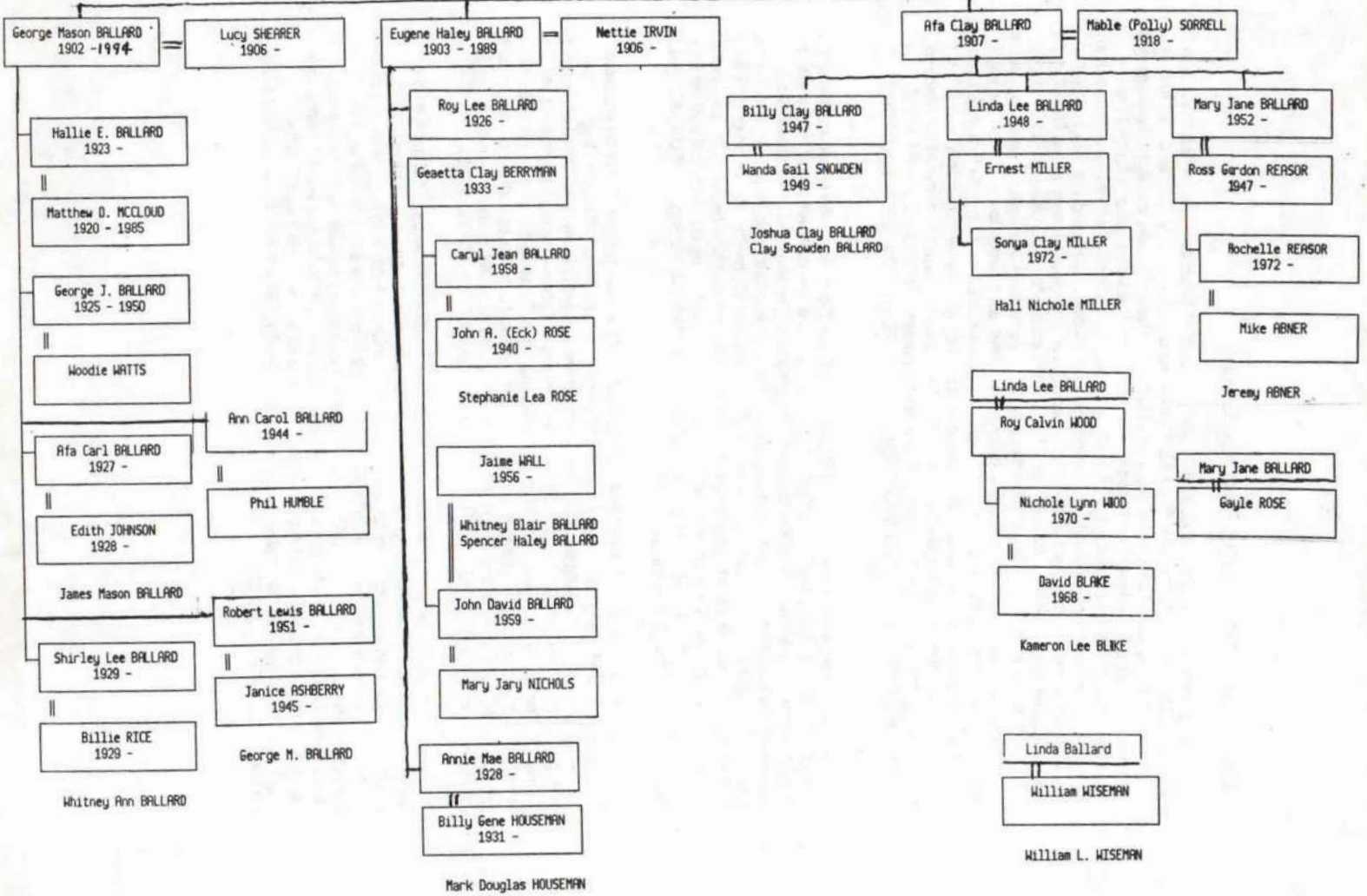

Thompson - Bk 54 p 232 - 201.125 acres at \$ 200 per acre - land situated in and near the southwestern suberb of Winchester, Clark Co Ky being south of the Boonesboro Turnpike Road and known as the dower tract in the land of James Ballard and bounded as follows : beginning at a stake on East margin of Water (Now Maple Street at its junction with North of the Boonesboro Turnpike Road .....
