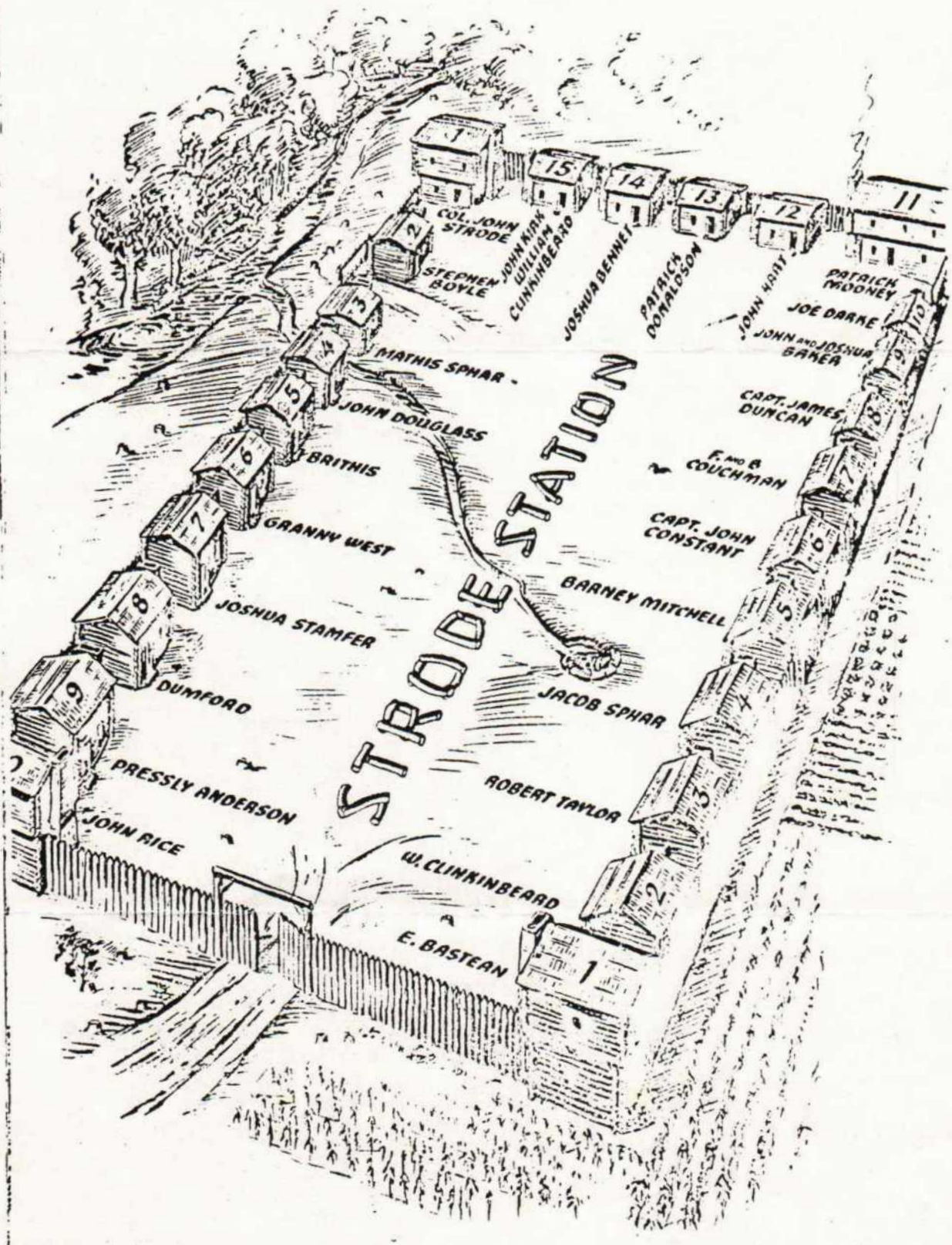

THANK YOU VERY MUCH FOR YOUR TIME TODAY.
I ENJOYED HEARING ABOUT WHAT WENT ON BACK
"HOME" IN CLARK COUNTY.

FIRST I'LL TELL YOU WHAT I KNOW OF THE
BOYLE FAMILY:

I KNOW STEPHEN BOYLE CAME TO STRODES STATION
IN 1779 AND THAT HIS WIFE'S NAME WAS MARTHA

THE JEFFERSON ENTRIES SHOW THAT HE CLAIMED
400 ACRES OF LAND ON THE HOWARD + LICKING
RIVERS ~~AND~~ IN 1780 AND 200 ACRES ON GREEN
CREEK IN 1784. HE TRANSFERRED THESE TO HIS
SONS, JAMES AND JOHN (THE LATTER PARCEL NOW
CALLED ~~Hunt~~ HUNTING'S FORK OF THE ADINE ON 8/28/1798.

HE DIED 7/11/1819 IN CLARK COUNTY. HE WAS
MENTIONED IN THE KENTUCKY GAZETTE IN JULY,
1789; NOV, 1795 AND OCT 1796.

His more famous sister, Mary or Polly Boyle was born in Culpepper Co VA on 2/22/1739 and married Capt John Strode. She died 1/10/39.

Stephen apparently had 2 sons, John and James. John married Jane Forman, dau of William Forman. He had 3 daughters, the last named Patsy C. Boyle who married John Rice of Lexington Ky.

John died in about 1807 and Jane married James Boyle, brother of John, her deceased husband. James was born 8/12/1776 and died 10/29/1845 in Linn County Mo. where he is buried.

James and Jane had several more children; Elizabeth, Harriet, John W (10/4/1809), Julia, Stephen A. (5/1814 d. 5/6/1902) Amanda, J.F.C (James 1819-1875) ~~AND~~ Cynthia J.

Sometime in the 1820's James and Jane moved the family to Missouri in the 1820's and settled in Chariton (later Linn County)

John W. married Zerelda Barbee of Bourbon Co. and Stephen A. married Mary Wilkerson. Stephen was my great-great grand father.

What I would eventually like to know is who was the father of Stephen and Martha. And where did they come from. If a lot of work has been done on Mary Strode, that would provide a clue. As far as I know, they all came from Berkley County VA and that their father could have been either a James, Stephen or Collins Boyle. Even William.

Just knowing what they did in Kentucky would be a help, or when they sold the farm there.

AT ANY RATE I ONCE AGAIN THANK YOU FOR YOUR TIME TODAY AND HOPE THIS SHEDS SOME LIGHT ON THE WHEREABOUTS OF THE BOYLE FAMILY OF CLARK COUNTY. ALSO, AS FAR AS I KNOW, JOHN BOYLE OF BOYLE COUNTY MAY NOT BE RELATED TO MY FAMILY BUT, WHO KNOWS.

Dear Mrs. Owens:

I know it's been over a year since we last corresponded, but I wanted to get back to you and thank you for the information regarding my family and the Strode family as related by Benjamin Allen.

As you remember, Mr. Allen spoke of Stephen Biles (Boyle(s)) correspondence with his father, urging him to move from Berkley Co. VA to Clark Co.. With that information I was able to trace Stephen back to Berkley Co. and find out that his father James Boyle(s) died there in 1758 when it was Frederick Co.. Stephen's brothers, William and Henry, were both in the Revolution and William died a prisoner of the of the British at New York after the fall of Ft. Washington in 1777.


It appears that the Boyle's owned property on the Warm Springs and Sleepy Creeks in western Berkley Co.. One could guess that the war and other circumstances helped Stephen through in his lot with his in-laws, the Strodes, and move to Kentucky. The Strodes probably came from Chester Co. PA about 1732. They first entered America through New Jersey, coming over on the ship "Paysay" in 1682.

When Stephen Boyle moved to KY, Henry and the rest of the family stayed in VA. Henry died there in 1811 or 1810.

That is about all there is to this point. Working backwards, I want to learn more about my families migration that put them in Va and the circumstances that brought Stephen Boyle's son, James, from Clark Co. to Missouri in the 1830's. I am sending along some information on my family which may or may not be of interest to you.

If there is any related genealogies done on the families I have mentioned, please let me know how I may go about getting the information. Thank You once again.
