The Christy Family

I. Samuel Christy came to Essex County, Virginia from England, prior to 1730.

He had four children, 2 sons and 2 daughters; thus:

- (1) Samuel Christy, Jr.
- (2) Mildred
- (3) Julius, born 1730 - died 1808, twin of
- (4) Juda, born 1730.

1. Samuel Christy, Sr. was married in England, before coming to America; he died in Virginia.

(1st) Samuel Christy, Jr. died of small pox, and also all of his family except one negro servant.

(2nd) Mildred (Milly) married Mudley.

(3rd) A Twin, Julius, born 1730, married Agatha Barnett, died 1808

(3rd) A Twin, Juda, born 1730, married Capt. John Gibbs, died 1808

2. Julius Christy, Sr. born 1730 in Essex County, Virginia died June 9, 1808 in Clark County, Kentucky.

Married in 1752 in Culpepper County, Virginia to Agatha Barnett of Culpepper; she being the daughter of _____

Julius was born and reared near Norfolk in counties of Gloucester, King and Queen and Essex near the mouth of York river.

His wife, Agatha was of Scotch and English descent. It is believed that the family came to Clark County, Ky. from Virginia about 1780 to 1800.

Julius Christy bought from Capt. Benj. Head and wife Martha 200 acres of land in Culpepper County, Virginia. (Deed Book, No. C, page 214, date of deed September 10th 1759. Will in Clark County, Ky. Dec. 5, 1805, probated 1808.)

Julius, age 22 or 23, a carpenter by trade; wife Agatha Barnett died Dec. 13, 1824. Their children were:

Frances Cain married William Cave, 1873 in
Culpepper County, Virginia; Sarah Davis;
Agatha Kertly; George; James, born 1766 (from
a letter dated 1844, age 78; Samuel married

Father Julius Christy, Sr. served in the Revolutionary War at its commencement and continued mostly on until it closed. (Will Book No. 8 Clark County, Ky. court Records page 357, Julius Christy Will. Date of Will Dec. 5, 1805, probated July 26, 1808.

3. John Christy, born Nov. 15, 1769 in Virginia. A shoe and boot merchant in Georgetown, Ky. died June 19, 1848 or 49 in Clark County, Ky., married 1798 or 99 to Hannah Whaley, daughter of James and Lettice Whaley of Fayette County, Ky. Hannah Christy died on June 15, 1855.

This couple lived in Georgetown, Ky. for four or five years. Then father Whaley was a farmer in Clark County, Ky. with negroes enough to cultivate it. This he gave to John and Hannah (Whaley) Christy. They moved to their farm, lived contentedly the remainder of John's life from about 1808 to 1848. (This part was copied from a letter of Kate F. Hunt to a Cousin of hers, Floyd Evans - - dated May 5, 1900.

Will of Peter Carter mentions a wife Hannah and children John, Edward, Melia Moss, Morris Vesle Carter, in case Morris died without issue, etc. his bequest go to "my son John Carter and Lettice Whaley". Unto my son-in-law James Whaley, Son-in-Law Thomas Moss, sons Ephraim and Elam Carter, daughter Molly Carter, sons Elihu Carter and James Carter, daughter Elizabeth Carter. " My youngest child by the name of Ann. This will was made June 4, 1784, codicil made March 28, 1787 to take care of daughter Fanny (who was born since making of last will), probated Feb. 9, 1801.

James Whaley's daughter Elizabeth, born Aug. 15, 1769 married John Gibbs on June 5, 1802 or 1805. There were three brothers in Loudoun County, Virginia: Thomas William, and James who were sons of James Whaley who died in Richmond County, Virginia 1749 or 1750.

Hannah Whaley daughter of James Whaley and Lettice Carter Whaley married John Christy. Frances Christy daughter of Hannah and John Christy, married Jephtha Hunt; George Jonathan ~~Wm~~ Hunt (son of Frances Christy and Jephtha Hunt married Mildred Haggard.

James Whaley of Fayette County, Ky.

James Whaley, who settled in Fayette County, Kentucky about 1765 was born probably about 1780 and either his oldest or second son was born in 1773. He died in Fayette County, Ky. Nov. 4, 1828.

Page 260 - Deposition of Noris Carter taken in Fayette Co. 29th April 1815 deposes In the year 1785 James Whaley settled on Boggs Fork of Boones Creek which land he purchased of William Elliott the same on which William Whaley has lived ever since this paid for Dec 15, 1785 Surveyed 1786 by John McKinley

In Peter Carter's will made in Loudon Co Va June 4, 1794 he mentioned daughter Lettice Whaley, son-in-law, James Whaley and among others Noris V. Sale Carter, the same mentioned above as a land witness to the land purchase.

In will Book 8, page 428, Lev, Ky. is the will of James Whaley in which he names his wife Lettice, children, Edward, James, Hannah Whaley, Christy, Susan Hudson and Elizabeth Whaley Gibbs and mentions Mrs. John, widow, the will was probated at Nov. Court 1826. From this record and further information given by Mrs Thomas Ware Proctor, his children then were as follows
