It seems that I have been completely stupid. You wrote me on Jan. 10, 1963 advising that you were getting a biographical dictionary of old settlers together and asking for something on Michael Dumford. Well, I got a little chronological record together and apparently did not send it. That's about the limit.

I finally woke up when I re-read your most interesting letter concerning locating Capt John

Hoeders mill. I am sending a copy of the Sumford material herewith and you may make any use of it you wish, assuming that you are still interested. Good luck in your undertaking.

I haven't anything equivalent for the Heulines. Yes, Mr. J. L. Hamline of 105 years ago is the same family (the name is spelled variously Heuline, Haveline and Hamline). Further John Heuline moved from Clarke to Montgomery county very early and Mr. Hamline has probably come back home to Clarke county to live.

If you want me to, I'll give the same kind of a record (i.e. chronological) for the Heulines

Enclosed is some more 'stuff' for your files. Someone gave the Historical Society some back issues of 'Bluegrass Roots' and I found them. You probably already have them--if so--just pitch them.

A daughter of one of the Solomon Dunfords married a Crowe and is Howard's ancestor. I'm interested in anyone living in the area around Ruckerville-Trapp-Log Lick and Vienna.

When I first saw the 1860 map of Clark Co., I wrote to Mr. Norris (Morris) who published the 1860 Census, and two months later he wrote that none was available--and he had filed my letter with his income tax!!!

At the time you wrote about the Census, I was not interested--I had come to a halt on any Adams research, so I had just quit. I learned the hard way to buy when it is offered!!! I never thought I'd be as interested as I am now. But it seems that we have come to another dead end with the Lowrys. The one logical answer is that Thomas Lowry was married before he married Nancy Dedmon. (He was over 40 when he married her) His sons could be Enoch, James and Ludwell.

As soon as I got Mr. Norris' letter, I ordered the 1860 microfilm and started copying. A friend helped me--but it was slow going. I had to send the film back before I was finished--but I have reordered. I have typed and indexed the first half (section) and have a lot of the second section copied. Tracy Patrick (Estill Co. Tribune) may be interested in printing it--if he wants to proof read it. I did it for my benefit--so I'm not going to go over it again. I'll give him my work--just to make it available to Clark Co. researchers. It is so frustrating not to be able to get records. I have worn your books to a nub, Nellie Fox's book has been great and the 1850 Census is disreputable !! Darlene Hounshell (Puckett descendant) and I have been corresponding. Her father owns land in the Vienna Area and is interested in the history.

I'm looking forward to Goff Bedford's third volumn. If you hear of anything that is published about Clark Co--let me know.

Hope you're OK. Howard is busy with his garden and I'm freezing

Dear Miss Owen,

I was in Winchester, Ky. last Thursday looking for an old DUMFORD family cemetery near that city. I stopped by the Court House and asked for help. The folks at the Clerk of Courts recommended that I call you but you were not at home. I have worked quite a long time in tracing my family tree and have found that DUMFORDS came up through Boonesboro and lived in that vicinity until 1866. Clark, Fayette and Madison Counties all had court house records of our family. This cemetery is supposed to be located on or near highway 89 between Winchester & Irvine. It's supposed to be in Clark County very close to the Estill & Madison County lines. This information is from U.S. Geological Survey Map SE/4 Winchester, Ky. Quadrangle. I have been down that road

looking for it but with no success. I did find one old cemetery that contained many TODD markers and have heard the 2 families were acquainted in that general area. I traveled old Rock-ersville Road, Red River Road but did not travel on Big Bone Lick Road and I know there were others that I missed. A 13 room "Dumford" Hall was even supposed to be near Winchester. Have you ever heard of this DUMFORD cemetery? This name was often misspelled DUNFORD, TUMPER, TUMPART & DUMPHORD.

The early Dumfords were Michael, Daniel, Solomon & John. John may have died fighting Indians. Michael must have been the father. Daniel and Solomon came to Clermont County, Ohio in early 1800's. I am descendent of Daniel, I think.

Can you please help me? Is there a public library in Winchester with old maps, books etc. Thanks for any help that you can give me!

Dear Ms. Owens,

My father, Howard Dumford, had contacted you by telephone last year on his vacation. He had learned that you have a real interest and knowledge about your area, he had heard that you are the town's historian. I would like any help and information about my ancestors that you may know. I am embarrassed not knowing if you do history as a hobby and interest or as a living (like genealogical hunters). We would be glad to cover cost, and honor your terms.

I had started to collect family history and stories in the last nineteen months. I wish that I had started many years ago! Three summers ago, my husband's family (Cable) had its first reunion in thirty years at Natural Bridge! We had been married twenty years and this was a first time to meet many in-laws that live in Kentucky near the homeplace (Fincastle and Beattyville). So a year ago, when I learned some of my ancestors had lived near Winchester, was I surprised! Finding our families had lived so close six generations ago was ironic to me.

The information that I hold is that Michael Dumford is buried near Winchester, see enclosed copy of information. He was born Ca 1735 and died 1790. He was a Revolutionary Soldier per article also enclosed. His wife's maiden name is unknown and Christian name in question: Sevilla or Sibelah per article. We do not know his parents, but he lived in Yodkin Valley, N. C. His son, Daniel is of our line, moved to Stonelick Twp., Clermont County, OH after he had married Sarah Horn in Jan. 13, 1787 in Madison Co., KY. We have a list of other children of Michael's, but not birthdays to put them in order. Would you have any additional information and/or stories about the Dumford family?

Now to add a new element. We have learned that my father-in-law's mother's family (Smyth) is holding a reunion in Winchester this August. We have not heard if it is to be August 1 or 8. We hope to attend. The "we" may be my husband, Dan, and myself or Dan and his father, Ray. Either way, we hope to be in touch with you at that time.

Going through my father-in-law's records, I came across a note that Robert Smith was writing a book about the Fincastle area. This note is ten years old. Do you know if this book was completed? Could you recommend any other reading to get to know your area and its people?

Do you know of Lillian Whisman Maloney? Her address is (or was) 1320 W. Lexington Ave. Ray Cable's notes stated that she was working on the Smyth Genealogy. Pearl Smyth who had helped her and Ray in gathering some of the Smyth family history, lives now at 321 South Maple with Kitty Booth as an attendant. Ms. Booth was the one that informed us about the Smyth Reunion. Would you know any of the three ladies?

Ray Cable's work was mainly on his father's side because he knew someone else (LWM) was working on his mother's side of the family. We are looking for more information about Dan's grandmother's, Rosa May Smyth's line if it is available.
