

Haggard History

as written by David D. Haggard

copied from the book now in the Genealogical Library at Salt Lake City, Utah, by Mildred C. McCarthy - 1954

The following is a history of the first son of Nathaniel Haggard, who was the oldest son of James Haggard, the original settler in America.

Henry Haggard, born in Albemarle County, Virginia, about 1744, died at the age of 90 years, he was a Baptist Preacher. Soon after the close of the Rev. War he moved to east Tennessee with his family, and after a period of years to Alabama, his children were James, David, Henry, Joel, Noah and Nancy.

Nancy married a Thacher, and with the Father and two brothers Joel and Noah moved to Alabama. Rev. James Haggard came to Kentucky in 1790 and settled in Fayette, County (Lexington). In 1821 he moved back to Sevier County, Tenn. He died in 1851 leaving 6 sons and several daughters, as follows: Martin, born 1785, Atchley, Jackson, James, Noah, and Porter; the daughters were Lydia, Polyne and Mary.

Martin, the eldest son of Rev. James raised 5 sons and 5 daughters as follows: Rev. James P. Haggard, Zachariah Haggard, Clayburn Haggard, Pleasant Haggard, Martin Haggard, Fannie Haggard, Mary Haggard, Elizabeth Haggard, Minerva Haggard, & Miriah Haggard.

The sons of James P. Haggard are William, George, Elijah, Murphy, Alexander; the daughters were Minerva, Elizabeth and Milly.

Atchey Haggard, son of Rev. James Haggard and Grandson of Henry Haggard, raised 4 sons, William M., James, Randall and Jasper. William M. resides at Maryville, Blount County, Tenn. James the son of Atchley Haggard died in 1878 and left one son, Noah who was born in 1862. P. O. Address, Milican, Tenn.

James the 4th son of Rev. James Haggard and Grandson of Rev. Henry Haggard moved to Jasper County Missouri about 1869 and died 1890; at one time he was County Judge; he leaves one son James, P.O. Address Sarcoxie, Mo.

Rev. Noah Haggard the 5th son of Rev. James Haggard, P.O. Box Blackoak, Sevier County, Tenn.

David Haggard, the 2nd son of Rev. Henry Haggard, was born in Albemarle County, Virginia 1767 He married Millie Elkin, came to Clark County, Kentucky in 1790, raised a family of ten children; they had: Polly, Lucy, Sally, Ezekiel E., Zachariah E., John F., Robert E., Nancy, Julia, Noah G., David J., Malissa M., Elizabeth D.

Ezekiel E. oldest son of (David Haggard, known as Bald Davy) and Grandson of Rev. Henry Haggard was born in 1798 in Kentucky, when a young man he went to Bowling Green Kentucky and married Malinda McAfee, they had 1 son and 5 daughters as follows:

Lucy J. Haggard, Married Mr. Carter, they reside at New Market, Marion Co., Ky.

Harriet Haggard, married Mr. Haydon, they resided near Lebanon, Ky.

Booker Haggard, married Rev. W. G. Inman.

Julia Haggard married Mr. S. Wright, they resided in Kansas City, Mo.

Malissa Haggard married Mr. Richardson, she is a widow and lives in Kansas City, Mo.

William David Haggard was the only son of Ezekiel E. and Malinda Haggard, he was born at New Market, Ky, Oct. 17, 1826 and educated at the Academy at Lebanon, Ky. He was 11 years old when his father died. He was a tax collector at Marion Co.; at 19 years old he then entered the office of Dr. Shuck at Lebanon 1847 graduated March 1851 Jefferson Medical College in Philadelphia. He located in Gallatin, Tenn. in May 1851, in 1859 he married Martha, the oldest daughter of Dr. and Mrs. Elmore Douglas, who

died 1866, they had 2 daughters, the eldest died in infancy, Louise Douglas Haggard born Gallatin, Tenn. May 4, 1860 married J. Y. Crawford 1885; they had 4 children: George died 1896 age 9 years

J. Y. born 1892

1897 in Nashville, Tenn.

two twin girls June Douglas and Mary Louise born

Dr. W.D. Haggard moved to Davidson County, Tenn. in 1864 from there to Nashville in 1875. He is a teacher of surgery (1899) In 1870 he married Jane Douglas, daughter of Mr. & Mrs. Robert B. Douglas, they had 2 children, William David Jr. born 1872 and Douglas born 1876 in Nashville, Tenn. (March 3rd)

William David Jr. graduated Louisville Ky., school of medicine 1893; he married Mary Laura Champe Jan. 18, 1899.

Zachariah Haggard, the 2nd son of Bald Davy born 1801 Clark Co., Ky., was Representative in Ky. legislature for Clark Co., Ky. 1828 to 1839; he married Zilpa Hodge. Their children were: Charles, Alvin B. Christopher Columbus, Adaline, Malissa, Elizabeth, James, Harvey, Jane, Marinda, William F., John & Louisa. No history on them except Alvin B. Haggard, he was born in Clark Co., Ky., Oct. 18, 1830 married Croatia A. Stevenson, second daughter of an old Ky. family on Feb. 27, 1868, they had 4 children:

William Rupert Haggard born 18 Dec. 1868, died in infancy.

Cinnie Belle Haggard, born 13 Feb. 1870, alive in 1899

Beverly Price Haggard, born 17 March 1873 "

Mary Zilpah Haggard born 20 March 1876 "

Alvin B. Haggard and family came to Hallsville, Mo., many years since, He died Oct. 14, 1890. The family now (1899) lives at Columbia, Mo.

Robert E. Haggard, son of Bald Davy was born in Clark County, Ky., 28 Sept. 1805; he married Rosaline Edmunson and moved to Scott Co., Ill. and settled near Winchester, Ill. They had 9 daughters, no sons, he was wounded and taken prisoner at the battle of Shiloh, April 1862, was in prison at Selma, Alabama for about 6 months when he was exchanged. His wounds totally disabled him, he died 19 October 1885.

David J., son of Bald Davy was born in Clark County, Ky, October 11, 1815; he married Sarah A. Edmunson of the same County, they moved to Scott County, Ill. and settled in Winchester, after many years they moved with their family to Saline County, Nebraska, where he died 29 November 1886. His wife Sarah A. Haggard died 12 Jan. 1897. They had 3 sons and 1 daughter.

Laura A. Haggard born 1 Nov. 1868 Scott Co. Ill.

David A. Haggard born 9 June 1870 Dupage Co. Ill.

Corwin R. Haggard born 23 June 1874 Dupage Co. Ill.; married 12th 1897, Althea Brooks Roberts, daughter of Cornelius Roberts and Elizabeth Brooks, she was born 2 Nov. 1873.

Ralph Waldo Haggard born 23 Aug. 1876 Dupage Co., Ill.

Zachariah W. Haggard, the 2nd son of David J. Haggard was born in Scott Co. Ill., 15 Sept. 1846 in Western Nebraska.

George T. Haggard, the 3rd son born 28 Nov. 1849 in Scott Co., Ill., has one daughter, Myrtle, born 22 Sept. 1883.

Sally E. Haggard (Shaw) only daughter of David J. Haggard was born 28 Nov. 1841 in Western Nebraska.

Rev. Martin Haggard, second son of Nathaniel Haggard was born in Albermarle Co., Va. 1748. At the age of 20 years he began to preach the Gospel. He with 5 others on horseback started west on a preaching tour. In east Tenn. and Ky in passing thru the mountain wilderness they were fired upon by Indians and he with 2 others were killed.

Rodney Haggard, son of Augustine L. Haggard and Lou Ann Mullins, Haggard, was born 3 October 1844 married February 1868 to Mary E. Baldwin, Daughter of W. W. Baldwin and Mary A. Eades, Baldwin. They had children:

Laland Haggard, Frank Hunt Haggard, Annie Mildred Haggard, Mary Rodney Haggard, John Henry Haggard, Rodney Haggard, Benjamin Wheeler Haggard. His father Augustine Lewis Haggard, son of David T. Haggard of Albemarle Co. Va., and Patsy Adams Haggard of Clark County, Kentucky, but originally from Virginia, was born in Clark Co. Ky., 3 June 1820, he died 19 December 1895 in Winchester, Ky, and buried in Mt. Olive Cemetery, where 3 generations of the family are resting; himself and wife, his father and mother, Grandfather and Grandfather, lie side by side. He was of English and Scotch blood.

Rev. James Haggard was born in Virginia 1759, married Betsy Gentry, moved to Kentucky in 1790 had 3 sons and one daughter as follows: Nathaniel, Dabney, Harmon, and Polly. About 1816 he and his family moved to Christian Co., Ky. 5 miles west of Hopkinsville and he preached in private homes until 1819, then with the assistance of Dawson Haggard they organized the West Union Baptist church with 12 members as follows:

1828, Samuel Lauder and wife Sally Haggard, Rev. James Haggard and his son Harmon Haggard moved to Sangamon Co., Ill., settled 3 miles west of Springfield, Ill. After preaching for 60 years he died at the age of 80 years.

Harmon Haggard, the third son of Rev. James Haggard was born in Clark Co., Ky., July 13, 1790, and went to Christian County Ky., with his father, on November 5, 1822 he married Sally Bartlett Steele, daughter of Archy and Betsey Steele, Sally Bartlett Steele born May 26, 1804.

Harmon Haggard and wife moved to Sangamon Co., Ill, in 1828, settled on a farm 3 miles west of Springfield, where they had 10 children. Harmon Haggard died Aug. 28, 1874 age 84 years, his wife Sally Bartlett Haggard died Sept. 3, 1852 age 84 years. Children living in 1889 were:

#2, Martin Haggard, born Jan. 2, 1836, married and lived at Labette Co. Kansas

#5, Robert Haggard lived to years of maturity, death date not given.

Bartlett Haggard, the 6th son of Nathaniel Haggard and Elizabeth born Albemarle Co., Va., 1763 married Martha Dawson, daughter of Rev. Martin Dawson, Bartlett died 1844 age 81 years. In 1788 they moved to Clark County, Ky.; they had 2 sons and 7 daughters: #1 Martin, married Elizabeth Kane, (Cain) they had 7 sons, 7 daughters. no record of the daughters, but the sons were:

Bartlett Denison, Allen Dawson, David, Henry, Martin, John, James. Bartlett Dennison Haggard married Harriet Arnold, they had 2 sons and 2 daughters, sons were Martin and James, no other records.

Allen Dawson Haggard, the second son of Martha and Bartlett was born July 3, 1805 near Winchester, Ky., died March 30, 1841, he married Francis Haggard, on November 17, 1825, they had 4 sons and one daughter:

Bartlett Shepherd born Apr. 20, 1828
George, James and Enoch
George had 4 daughters and 4 sons, as follows: Mary, Elizabeth, Emma, Minnie, Albert Bush, George Nevill, Allen Dawson.

James, the second son of Allen Dawson Haggard had 3 sons and 6 daughters: Bartlett S., Leland, Wheeler L., Annie M., Rachel B., Nettie M., Lou S., Fannie S., Robie T. Ella and Alice.

Enoch, the 4th son of Allen D. resides in Texas, has 4 sons and 3 daughters as follows: Colby, Clifton, Walter, Aquilla, Jennie Laura, Mary.

David Haggard the fifth son of Nathaniel and Elizabeth was born in Albemarle Co., Va. 1763. In 1779 David Haggard married Miss Nancy Dawson, daughter of Rev. Martin Dawson, in 1792 they moved to Clark Co., Ky., where they raised 2 sons and 8 daughters; In 1823 they moved to Trigg Co., near the cerulean springs, about 12 miles west of Hopkinsville and in 1836 to Bloomington Ill., where he died at the age of 80 years.

Elizabeth, the oldest of David and Nancy Haggard was born in Albemarle Co., Va. 1791 and with her Father and Mother went to Ky 1792, she was married to John S. Lauder in 1812, abt. 1816 they moved to Christian Co., Ky., near Hopkinsville, and raised 7 children; she died 1833.

Sally Haggard the third daughter of David and Nancy Haggard was born in Clark Co., 1803, she came to Christian Co. to visit her sister Batsy Lauder and brother Dawson Haggard in 1819, and met Samuel Lauder, they were married in 1821, in 1835 they moved to Bloomington, Ill, where she died in 1842, they raised the following children:
John D., Charles W., Richard M., and Zerelda.

John D. Born 1822 died in Kansas abt. 1889
Charles W. born April 1828 living in 1889
Richard born 1830 living in 1889
Zerelda

Samuel Lauder the husband of Sally Haggard lived to 93 years, died abt. 1886 in Bloomington, Ill.

Melvina the 4th daughter of David and Nancy Haggard born in Clark Co. 1805 went to Trigg Co., Ky. with her parents in 1823. She married Ludwell E. Rucker of Shelby Co. in 1830, in 1835 they moved to McLean Co., Ill., near Bloomington. They had 4 children: Lucy, Sarah Elizabeth, she married Joseph Humphreys, they had 4 sons:
William L. Rucker married Isabel C. Haggard, he died May 4, 1870 at Bloomington, Ill.
George E. Rucker, their youngest son married Lucy Ellen Ballard daughter of William L. and Mary Ballard in 1876, they moved to Baxter Springs, Kansas, they had 2 children, twins -- William Rucker and Mary Bell Rucker.

Cynthia Haggard the 5th daughter of David and Nancy Haggard was born 1808; she married Isham Babbitt, in 1825 they moved to Hancock Co. near Groveland, Ky. and later to Putman Co. where he died. They had 2 daughters and 3 sons: Teresa, Malissa, William W. John W. and Frank. The first three dead in 1889.

Mahalla, sixth daughter of David and Nancy Haggard married James R. McCaughan in 1828, in 1834 they moved to Smith Co., Miss. They had seven sons and no daughters.

Louesa and Louisa, the 7 and 8 daughters of David and Nancy were twins, they were born in Clark Co., Ky., 1813, with their parents moved to Trigg Co., Ky., in 1823. Louesa married William S. Blakely in 1830 settled near Cerulean Springs, had 6 sons and 1 daughter, as follows:

James D. married Virginia K. Bryant

John D. married Alice Blakely

Louise married John H. Endsly and died many years prior to 1889

William H. lived in Solwing Green, Ky. he was a physician, married Betty South.

Charles T. married Ladd

Edward T. married Fanny Lauder

Lee A. married Fanny Rogers

Louisa, the other twin married William G. Thompson in 1832, they lived in Cades, Ky., until 1835 then they moved to Bloomington, Ill., where she died in 1838; they had one son who died in infancy. Mr. Thompson died a few years after her.

Dawson Haggard son of David and Nancy was born June 1793 in Clark Co., Ky., married June 1813 Charity Baldwin, the youngest daughter of Samuel and Mary Baldwin of Montgomery Co., Ky. she died in 1849 Bloomington, Ill., In 1818 they moved to Christian Co. Ky. and later to Trigg Co. where he died Sept. 1829.

Their oldest son Samuel Baldwin Haggard was born Nov. 8, 1814 Clark Co., died Austin, Ill. Feb. 11, 1899 age 85; his Grandfather David Haggard born in Virginia, when 21 years old Samuel B. Haggard moved to Bloomington, Ill. making the journey on horseback. In 1843 he went to Chicago, making the journey in a wagon, the trip taking a week. He married Mary Mason a native of Ky., she died in 1889. He was the oldest of 7 brothers and sisters, the youngest of whom is 70 years old, they are all alive in 1889 They had 7 children as follows:

Isabelle C. born Sept. 16, 1842, she married No. 17, 1864 William L. Rucker, they had one son.

John was born in Va. about 1750 married Jane Gibson in 1773, about 1787 John and William moved to Middle Tenn. John and wife had 4 children, Edmund, Elizabeth, John, and Samuel. The parents had sent Edmund, Elizabeth and Samuel to drive up the cows, while they were gone, Indians came upon the parents, killed them burning their home, books and records. Some neighbors fleeing the Indians met the 3 children and took them to safety. As we can find no record of John we suppose that he was killed with his parents. The 3 remaining children were taken by their Uncle, William Haggard to Montgomery County, Ky. with whom they lived until they were grown.

When a young man he went to Tenn. and married Elisabeth Rogers in 1818 then moved back to Georgia where he lived and died. He was father of three sons, James E., William R. and John: William R. Haggard died Feb. 7, 1899 near Harmony Grove, Georgia. Of John we have no history. James E. Haggard the eldest son was born 30 October 1819 married Martha G. Wilson in 1843, he died at the old Homestead Harmony Grove, Ga. March 1, 1899, his wife Martha G. died Oct. 31, 1898, they had 4 children -- 2 sons and 2 daughters.

G.J.S. Haggard, one of the sons, post office is Ringold, Ga.

James B. Haggard the second son was born at Harmony Grove, Ga. July 2, 1858 his post office address is Atlanta Ga., married and 6 children, 3 sons and 3 daughters, account of only one daughter of James E. Miss Oregon Haggard born at the old homestead, Harmony Grove, March 22, 1850 unmarried in 1899.

Henry Haggard son of Gray born in North Carolina in 1775 afterward moved with his family to Powells Valley, Virginia, later to Grassy Valley, East Tenn. He had one son, John who was born in Tenn. 1793-

John Haggard, son of Henry Haggard and Grandson of Gray, had 4 sons as follows: William F., Henry, John, and Edward. Their Father John and Grandfather Henry both died at Rock Castle, Ky. There were also three daughters of whom we have no record.

William F. Haggard son of John and Grandson of Henry, Great Grandson of Gray was born in Tenn, but moved with his parents in an early day to Rock Castle, Ky. and many years ago to Excelsior Springs, Mo., He was a soldier in the Union Army, he raised 4 sons: John, William, Leander and Joseph, in 1899 they resided in Longton, Elk County, Kan. They had one sister who married Benjamin Matthews who resided at Echo, I.T. (?)

Henry Haggard brother of William F. Haggard recently died at Rock Castle County, Ky. No history on him.

John Haggard also a brother of William F. Haggard born at Rock Castle County, Ky. in 1827, where he still resided in 1899, P. O. Box Gum Sulphur.

Edward Haggard the youngest brother of William F. Haggard born at same place, in 1899 lived at Eagle Lake, Minn. has a son Henry E. Haggard at Eagle Lake, Minn.

Item, I give to my wife Elizabeth Haggard all my estate real and personal during her life time or during her widowhood. I give to my son Nathaniel Haggard the plantation house whereon I now live and the same land and plantation to be valued by three discreet persons and my said son to receive of the said plantation and land at the value so as to be upon an equality with the rest of my children and if valued to more than an equal share the surplus to be paid equally to the rest of my children and if valued less the rest of my children to pay cash on an equal share round so as to bring the said Nathaniel Haggard upon a equality one with another. I have been quite anxious to locate material on the marriage of David Kindred and Talitha Ramney which was dated ~~no~~ 30, 1809. I correspond with one of their descendants and she just recently lost her husband, so, I have been searching for data to rebuild her interest in her research.

To answer your question about Edward Kindred, yes, from what we have found he was a Baptist preacher - married to Elizabeth Haggard, she being a sister to Mary C. (Polly) Haggard who married William Kindred - brother of Edward.

My husband and I are trying to compile a complete history on the Kindred families as we can. This is our first venture into research and we find it quite thrilling yet, much more of a task than we ever thought at the time we started. We have been reading microfilm in search of records and that is where we found the reference to the will of Edward Kindred. Book 7 page 696. it stated.

My husband's great great Grandparents Wm and Mary C. (Polly) Haggard Kindred settled in Clark Co. in the late 1700's from information we have found in records. We have been given a date of March 17, 1780 as the date of their marriage. However, this we haven't any proof concerning the date. Their son William Kindred married Mary R. Garland. We have been unable to obtain any data concerning the birthdates or date of marriage for them. They are Ken's great Grandparents. Their son Sylvester being his Grandfather. Here again, we are at a loss for data. He married Mary Jane Terry daughter of Erach Terry and Sarah Frances Lytton from information we have from family members but, to date, we have found no facts.

It is our hope to be able to go into Kentucky this summer in search of more family data. We believe the older William stayed in Clark Co. until his death as I have a copy of his will. Also his military records as he fought in the Revolutionary War. Wm^{#2} in the war of 1812 being wounded in left hand.

Any suggestions you may have as to our obtaining the records I've mentioned would be greatly appreciated and I will be glad to send a check to cover the cost of obtaining copies.
