Dear Kathryn,

I received your Christmas card yesterday, the first to arrive. It is nice to hear from you again. I have not yet bought cards this year, so had best reply by letter. To bring you up to date, I have been very busy, obtained a divorce from Susy which was just effective 21 of Nov. We are still friends and she has moved to SC and living with one of her sons.

Your story about the bottle is interesting, I wonder which Martin that could be. I have never heard of any of mine being in the pharmacy business, but who knows.

You inquired about the John Martins in my line:
John Martin(1) m. Rachel Pace, both bur. Lower Howards Crk.
John Martin (2) m. Mary Elkin. I do not know when they died, or where they are buried. They just seem to disappear. This John was the Captain of the Ky. Militia, War of 1812. He also built the Clark House (hotel and tavern). This was not too far from the courthouse. You mention a John W. Martin, married three times and operated a hotel, I have no middle name or initial for any of my three John Martins and no information that any of them married more than once, but who knows? John Martin(3) was known as "Captain Jack" he m. Mary Fairfax Carter They are both bur. in the old Eubank farm, Thomson Station Rd. He too was in War of 1812, but was about 16 years of age and a private. Later on he may have become a Captain in the Militia or the title Captain may have been an "honorary" one. I have found no record of this simply because I have not looked for it.

You also mention McMachen thinking there were mistakes in John Robert Martin's book. In corresponding with other descendants, they have different information on some of the allied lines. He only came down to my John Martin (1) as I recall. I have verified the information from Martin Martin m. Sarah Hix and having son, Valentine, through parish records; Valentine and Jane through will records (the surname BRIDGEWATER) usually quoted is not verified, no marriage record found. That John Martin(1) was their son is proven by Valentine's will and deed of John and Rachel of property in Va.

I hope that clears up these three John Martins. Authors of "history" books have certainly fouled up their accounts of my unimpressive Martins. First I found that the book, "Remember the Raisin" confused John (2) and (3). If the author had bothered to check his own dates he would have caught his error.

Then Goff Bedford had John(1) killed by Indians (he had misread the Clark Co. Chronicles, it was McMillion (sp.?)

The latest is Thomas Clark's recent history of Clark Co., which has a photo of the John(1) house and brightly says Dr. Robert Martin (son of the sheriff) spent his childhood there. I guess there were too many John Martins, especially in Clark Co.

You may be interested to know I have found out who William N. Lane was. In three different books I have read, the eldest son of Col. Joseph was named as William Carr Lane who had married a Miss Taylor and moved to Ky. Perrin said he was born in Jeffersontown, Va. (now W. Va.) The will of Mary Fairfax Lane who m. (1) William Miller and (2) John Woodford, proves beyond any doubt who Wm. N. Lane was. He was the eldest son of Joseph and Mary Newton Lane, and married Mildred Taylor. So he was the brother of my Sarah Newton Lane. Apparently Wm. N. Lane brought his widowed mother, Mary (NEWTON) Lane and at least three

sisters with him to Clark Co. (Martha, who m. Geo. Webb, Mary F. who m. (1) Miller, (2) Woodford and Sarah Newton who m. Job Carter. I also found in Fayette Co. records that mama Mary made a marriage contract with a John Pickett of Scott Co., she was described as being of Clark Co. and had two unmarried daughters. One thing I have not checked on yet, is that a John Pickett bought some land from James Bell, one of the witnesses was Walter Karrick, which makes me wonder if this land was in Clark Co. I find it peculiar that these records show up in Fayette Co.

I almost forgot, Col. Joseph Lane never moved out of Westmoreland Co., Va. and all of his children were under age at the time of his death so all of these Lane children were born in Westmoreland. Where Perrin got the information that Wm.N. Lane was born in Jeffersontown is of course unknown. I do know that some of the sons wound up in PA, and one did move to Jeffersontown, but that was after they became adults.

Well, I have almost written a book, I'll give your eyes a rest! I hope you are well and managing ok, keep in touch. Guess I'm not through yet-- old age makes me forgetful-- is June Neville Blakemore still living? I ran into a lady on the computer who has Neville and Blakemore ancestors. -Bobbin-

THE JOHN MARTIN FAMILY

John Martin was probably the eldest son of Valentine Martin and Jane Bridgewater. In 1757 he was married to Rachel Pace a relative of Mary Pace, wife of Rev. William Baskett. John is named in his father's Will. He was born in Goochland County, Virginia in that part which later became Cumberland County. His boyhood was spent in a part of Virginia that was very sparsely settled at that time. Evidently he liked this because later on in life he removed to Clark County Kentucky and assisted in settling that section of the country.

According to Rev. William Douglass' Register John Martin and Rachel Pace were married January 3, 1757. About 1770 John and Rachel Pace Martin moved from Goochland County, Virginia, to Fluvanna County Virginia. In the fall of 1786 the following children of John and Rachel Martin moved to Fayette County, Kentucky, now Clark County, William, Orson, John and Valentine, Hannah and husband Obadiah Baber, Rachel and husband Francis Bush. The Babers settled on Four Mile Creek in Clark County. In 1844 Rachel, Valentine and Hannah were still there. — Rejected Pension File of Hannah, wife of Obadiah Baber. R-347 Va.

John Martin and his nephew, John Martin built a mill on Lower Howard's Creek in Clark County, Ky. It has not been definitely established as to the parents of the nephew, John Martin. John and Rachel are buried on the old Martin Farm on Lower Howards Creek, Happy Hollow, Bush Farm, Clark County, Ky.

Cousin Sylvia Pettit Welch, 2700 Sea Island Drive, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, states: The Old John Martin-Rachel Pierce (Pace) stone house was in part still standing when I used to go there. The grave yard was a short distance from the house. Two John Martins built the mill, probably a nephew. When I was there Rachels' grave stone inscription could still be read after scratching it with a rock, but there was nothing on John's stone that could be read. But the older cousin, with me, had been there years before and has the dates from his stone. From there, on two different occasions, we went to see the old home place of John and Elizabeth Lewis Martin, as Mr. Conkright said, "Just a mile as the crow flies", but it was farther by road, but, in those days they would be close neighbors. I lived about twelve miles from this old place. — Sylvia Welch.

John Martin and wife, Rachel (Pace) 26 January 1795 sold 390 acres in Fluvanna County, Va., to Samuel Smithson of Fluvanna County, Rachel relinquished her dower but couldnt travel. Book 1 page 341-6-30, Book 1 page 3-463 105 a.

Lucy Martin George stated that two or three years after her birth had moved to Goochland County, Va.

John Martin saw service in the Revolutionary War and was with Daniel Boone in Kentucky as early as 1775, some say possibly 1770. It is quite possible that he received land grants in Kentucky as did others of his kinsmen. His nephews, the Baskett Family, also settled in Clark County, Kentucky. See first part of this record.

John Martin and Rachel Pace have a host of descendants and they are to be found in many sections of the country. Many of the families are still unaccounted for, but perhaps some will recognize their ancestors or kinsmen in this record and will come forth and identify themselves. Most of the ones whom I have contacted have been very generous with their information and have indicated their eagerness to be identified within the pages of this book. Where there are no written records, history is lost. The same holds true in preserving a record of our family relationships. (J.R.M.)
